

## Testing Maths Horizons Resources

Maths Horizons has worked with sector experts to design resources to support effective classroom practice. We have developed questions intended to promote successful engagement with problem solving by offering different types of mathematical value.

We are now seeking feedback on their suitability for classroom use. We would like to understand:

- the reasoning and discussion they generate
- pupils' engagement and confidence
- the level of challenge provided
- their accessibility to a wide range of pupils.

### How you can help

We invite you to trial a selection of our questions with your class. Each resource pack contains a series of tasks to be used with pupils.

You are free to choose the questions you would like to use. For example, you might select questions linked to recently taught content to support application of new learning. Alternatively, you might select questions based on content from prior years that pupils are already secure with, requiring them to identify the relevant mathematics. Curriculum content statements associated with each question are provided in the slide notes for reference, but questions are not restricted to particular year groups. Developing confidence and expertise in problem solving may be particularly effective when using mathematical content from earlier years.

How you use the questions is up to you: teacher-led, small group or individual work. You can use the questions as they are written or adapt them.
